Cover Letter Sample: Winston Roberts

Winston contacted me to write his cover letter and resume for a Golf Course Superintendent position. He explained he only had one chance at this opportunity and wanted to get it right the first time. These positions rarely come open in the NE, as being a GCS was akin to “being on the Supreme Court,” once in, you served for life.

He forwarded the detailed position description which was very helpful. The key was maintaining tradition and history. Even though he had helped increase membership, sales, and event revenue in his current and previous position, it was not a requirement or mentioned in the description. They had a waiting list for members and all events sold out in advance, so the emphasis was on maintaining the status quo and not jeopardizing the strong record of success the club already obtained.

I went to Old Oak’s website and incorporated some key phrases into his cover letter. I also copied the dark blue color and font type they used on their website so Winston will seem familiar to them and on their team, even on paper. I found a nice golfer icon to use, with the head of the golf club pointing to a nice quote from a local paper.

Winston made the cut. The interview process is lengthy and Winston has been invited back for a second interview and is very optimistic for his chances.
